LOCATION

CHARTRES (28): J.Cochet and CRJS sports halls.

MAINVILLIERS (28): P.Coubertin and B.Maroquin sports halls.

The access to the various sports halls will be joined to the notification.

_{badminton} enrolment

➤ You must send your enrolment form before **May 11th**, 2007 to the following address: Lesage Marc 13 rue André Juillot, 28300 Mainvilliers.

The payment (by cheque to the order of Bapama) must be joined to your enrolment.

- → single competition fee: 11 euros
- → double competition fee: 17 euros
- > The number of players being restricted to 350, only the first enrolments will be taken into account.
- > Players can enrol for doubles without any partner but without being assured to get one.
- ➤ Players can enrol for doubles without any partner but without being assured to get one. Every enrolled player has to be aware of the sanctions in case of forfeit after the lots have been drawn (see the forfeits rules). The player will have to warn the club about his/her forfeit and to post the justifications in the required time to the Commission Régionale des Tournois de la Ligue du Centre de Badminton.
- ➤ No enrolment will be done over the phone.

LICENCES

badminton

- ➤ The players must be licensed when they enrol as they will be checked on the premises.
- ➤ Players playing in a different age category then theirs must be able to show the adequate justification otherwise they will be denied the right to play.
- Any unlicensed player faces the article LCB-CRA-002.

Disciplines

- ➤ The tournament is open to players in the following categories: NC, D, C, B, A et Élite (Top 50).
- ➤ Disciplines: men's and women's singles, men's and women's doubles, mixed doubles.
- ➤ Players can enrol in 2 disciplines but only in the same category.
- ➤ The number of players will be limited in each discipline:
- for the singles and mixed doubles competition, a group system will be used first followed by a straight knock-out system.
- for the doubles competition, a straight knock-out system or a group system will be used according to the number of enrolled players.
- ➤ The organizing committee, with the umpire agreement, reserves itself the right to gather some disciplines according to the number of enrolled players.
- ➤ The tournament will take place according to the FFBA official rules.

badminton

Umpire

- The head umpire of this tournament is Roingeau S.; she will be assisted by 4 umpires: Lesage L., Vedeau L., Renaud D. et Le Dilosquer J.
- ➤ With the exception of the finals, players will umpire their own matches.
- The club young players will be linesmen for the finals.
- ➤ The organizing committee, with the umpire agreement, reserves itself the right to change the matches schedule if necessary.
- > Any player or double absent on the court 5 minutes after being called faces a disqualification whatever the stage of the competition.
- ➤ Once called, players have 3mn to start their match.
- ➤ Players wishing to leave the premises for a while must warn the umpire.
- The umpire is chosen by the organizing committee. He can partially or totally disqualify any player disrespecting the rules. His/her decisions are final.
- A proper badminton outfit is required on the court.

Shuttles

- > Players must bring and share their own shuttlecocks. In case of dispute, the official ones will be used.
- > Shuttlecocks will be provided by the organizers for the finals.
- ➤ The official shuttlecock is the MAVIS 500 for non-ranked players and the Victor Tourney for ranked players (sold on the premises).

FORFEITS

- Players announcing a forfeit after the lots have been drawn will have to justify it by sending the required documentation to the organization, preferably before the competition, if they want to be paid back.
- Any unjustified forfeiting player faces the article LCB-CRA-001.
